

Detailed rules for certain job positions

Instructors, Researchers, Teachers

Educational or research activities may be performed:

- a) full-time or part-time, under fixed-term or open-ended employment contracts,
- b) commission-based contracts (lecturer, contracted researcher), or
- c) within the framework of a clerical relationship. For each legal relationship, the following legal regulations apply, with deviations as defined in Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education.

Employees:

The College's employees perform their duties full-time or part-time, under fixed-term or open-ended employment contracts, to which the provisions of Act I of 2012 on the Labour Code must be applied.

Persons with commission-based assignments:

Their activities are governed by the provisions on commission-based contracts in Act V of 2013 of the Civil Code.

Instructors with clerical status:

Their legal status is governed by Act CCVI of 2011 on Freedom of Conscience and Religion and the Legal Status of Churches, Denominations and Religious Communities.
