## Calculation of Regular Social Support

- (1) Scholarship Pool: sp = the amount available for this purpose from the current year's budget, based on the Higher Education Act and the College regulations.
- (2) Social Score: p = the score achieved by students in the course of the social support application.
- (3) Minimum Scholarship: ms = identical to the minimum amount of the academic scholarship defined by law<sup>1</sup>.<sup>2</sup>
- (4) Scholarship Threshold: st = the minimum score determined by the evaluation committee<sup>3</sup>.
- (5) Number of Scholarship Students: n = the number of students eligible for scholarship who have achieved a score higher than the scholarship threshold.
- (6) Variable Scholarship Pool: vsp = the remaining part of the scholarship pool after distributing the minimum scholarships to those entitled.

 $vsp = sp - (n \times ms)$ 

(7) Point Value in Forints: pvf = the amount distributable per point earned above the threshold.

pvf = vsp /  $\Sigma$  (p - st)

(8) Scholarship Due to the Student: sds = the standardised value of the scholarship calculated based on the score achieved by the student.

 $sds = ms + (p - st) \times pvf$ 

- (9) The minimum scholarship (ms) is distributed to eligible students.
- (10) The total of the distributed minimum scholarships must be deducted from the monthly scholarship pool: this is the variable scholarship pool (vsp).
- (11) From the scores achieved by students, the threshold amount (st) corresponding to the value of the distributed minimum scholarship must be deducted for each student. The resulting figures must be summed. amount of the variable scholarship pool must be divided by this total. This yields the point value in forints for the remaining points (p st).
