

Special Scholarship for Disadvantaged Students Regulations

- 1.) Within the framework of the project “Institutional Developments at The Dharma Gate Buddhist College,” EFOP-3.4.3-16-2016-00024, the College undertook to develop a scholarship system for students from socio-culturally disadvantaged backgrounds. To this end, with the agreement of the Maintainer Church, and from project funds constituting the College’s own revenue, the Senate awards an additional scholarship, through the application procedure defined in these Regulations, to students belonging to the project’s target group, in addition to the social and performance-based support otherwise provided [STBR 3.2.2.4], as follows.
- 2.) Target group requirements: residence in a disadvantaged region, disadvantaged status [NHEA Section 108, Point 10], lack of skills [NHEA Decree Section 62 (2)–(7)], disability [NHEA Section 108, Point 6].
- 3.) Scholarship application: the scholarship application shall be announced internally, and active-status students of the College may apply. Their disadvantaged status must be substantiated by official documents (residence card, medical certificate). They consent to the processing of their personal and special categories of data.
- 4.) The amount of the scholarship shall be HUF 10,000 (ten thousand forints) per month during the months of the study period in the first semester of support, and HUF 15,000 (fifteen thousand forints) per month in subsequent semesters.
- 5.) The awarding of the scholarship shall be decided by the Rector in office, as project owner, on the basis of the submission of the professional director at the time.
- 6.) The scholarship shall be paid exclusively from project funds and shall not otherwise affect the College’s budget.
- 7.) These Regulations, for the purpose of implementing the project “Institutional Developments at The Dharma Gate Buddhist College,” EFOP-3.4.3-16-2016-00024, shall apply throughout the entire duration of the project (from 1 August 2017 to 30 September 2021), with retroactive effect.
